## **Evangelism Contact Persons**

Their overall tasks are as follows:

- To visit churches, congregations, and training institutions in their respective churches to identify training needs with regards to evangelism in general, Gospel and popular culture, evangelism and interfaith dialogue, and evangelism and congregational development;
- To develop training materials for contextual, contemporary evangelism for pastors, evangelists and lay people in their respective churches;
- To conduct trainings on contextual, contemporary evangelism within their respective churches;
- To develop contextual, contemporary evangelism materials for grassroots use;
- To assist with regional and inter-regional exchanges on evangelism;
- To work in close cooperation with the UEM Executive Secretary Evangelism and the network of Evangelism Contact Persons to exchange ideas, materials, and assist each other in the tasks of the job (this includes participation in annual workshops on regional, sub-regional or international level organized by the UEM Evangelism Department and occasional exchange visits as organized by the department).

UEM is looking for:

- Full-time church workers (pastors, evangelists, teacher-preachers, catechists, bible women, deacons or deaconesses, youth workers etc.) who will remain in their position but be seconded to this particular program for part of their working time;
- Men and Women under forty years of age;
- Experience in and sound theological understanding of evangelism work;
- Creativity and willingness to try out new methods and approaches;
- Willingness to be trained and to learn;
- Interest and ability to work in an international and intercultural team;
- Ability to communicate in English (Reading, writing, speaking and listening).

Contact Persons will be nominated by their respective churches. Nominations must be made before December 31, 2016. Appointments will be made by UEM in January 2017.

All chosen contact persons are expected to attend an international training workshop in Germany, May 1-16, 2017.
