

## **International M.A. Diaconic Management (IMADM)**

### **Interdisciplinary Contextual Studies in Normative Governance Course IV - 2018-2020**

The two year's Master Course follows a multi-disciplinary concept, integrating theological, ethical and economic management perspectives. It is based on a comprehensive understanding of diaconia uniting the aspects of care, management, advocacy, Christian ethics, spirituality and political action in a global view.

#### **Studying Globally - Managing Contextually - Acting Responsibly**

Themes of the curriculum are

- Intercultural Theology and Theology of Diaconia
- The History of Diaconia in Different Contexts
- The St. Gallen Management Model (SGMM)
- Principles of Economics and History of Economic Thought
- Management Theory with a special emphasis on Normative Management
- Public Leadership in African/Asian Contexts
- Normative, Strategic, Operative Management
- Organisational Culture
- Leadership and Theology, Public Theology
- Ethical Questions of Globalisation
- The Ecclesiological Challenge of Poverty
- Inclusion of People with Disabilities

The program includes lectures, seminars and scientifically reflected field research in Asia, Africa and Europe. On top, individual own academic studying, research and text production is required (see documentation on MADM).

Students live and study together in an international, inter-cultural composed „Learning Community“. In sections of four to five weeks each they study in

- Jakarta Theological Seminary, Indonesia      September/October 2018
- Stellenbosch University, South Africa      January/February 2019
- Silliman University, Philippines      April/Mai 2019
- Sebastian Kolowa Memorial University (SEKOMU), Tanzania  
September/October 2019
- Institute for Diaconic Management (IDM), Protestant University of Wuppertal/Bethel,  
Germany      January/February 2020

The Graduation is scheduled for September 2020.

The total costs for the MA Program, including travel, accommodation and study fees amount to € 35.000 for the two years. Scholarships can be sought from UEM and other organisations.
