## Online Seminar School Partnerships: Reopening schools in the midst of COVID-19


Schools were closed for a long time and some are still closed. In Indonesia and Germany, schools are now to be resumed in the middle of the pandemic. Currently, schools as the most important educational institutions are facing similar challenges.

How can schools be successfully opened in the middle of a pandemic? What challenges does this entail? How can everyday school life be organized in such a way that it is safe for students and teachers and at the same time schools can fulfill their educational mission?

The online seminar will address these questions and show possible solutions. No ideal solution will be presented, but rather new perspectives will be adopted through a collegial exchange.

They will be given the opportunity to network internationally and to build up or expand the chance school partnership commitment.
